On Monday April 25, 2022, at 7:00 p.m., Mayor Kingan led the Pledge of Allegiance and called the regular Town Council meeting to order with the following being present: Mayor Ralph Kingan, Councilman Doug Schrader, Councilman Joel Morgan, Councilman Justin Robb, and Clerk/Treasurer Barbara Craig. Absent: Councilman Mike Phipps. **CONSENT AGENDA:** Councilman Morgan made a motion to approve the Consent Agenda. Items approved under the Consent Agenda include the regular meeting minutes conducted on April 11, 2022, Approval of Vouchers in the amount of \$74,137.07 including payroll. Approval of the Consent Agenda for the meeting held on April 25, 2022. Councilman Robb seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. **REPORTS:** Chris Roemmich presented the Public Works, Ag Complex reports. **DISCUSSION:** Pat Neely requested funding for the meal for the High School 2A State Golf Tournament to be held at the Hay Creek Golf Course, on Sept 6, 2022. The Wright Branch Prevention Coalition came to the meeting to request the Town Council waive the fees for the Southern Campbell Ag Complex for a BBQ and a Movie. Greg Worthen Visionary Representative discussed with the Town Council the request from Visionary for them to be able replace the old tower with a new tower and to build a new shed to be placed on town property and also to discuss a lease agreement with the Town of Wright. Councilman Morgan made a motion to approve the request to waive the fees for the Southern Campbell County Ag Complex for the Wright Branch Prevention Coalition for a BBQ and a movie on June 18, 2022, Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Robb made a motion for the Town Attorney Rick Erb to move forward with the preparation of a lease agreement between The Town of Wright and Visionary for using the Town of Wright Property for a new tower and a small building to house equipment related to internet services for the Town of Wright, Councilman Morgan seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Morgan made a motion to approve the **second** read of Ordinance 2022-02 An Ordinance of the Town of Wright, Wyoming for the annual appropriations for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, and ending June 30, 2023, Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried with all Ayes. Councilman Robb made a motion to approve the **first** read of the Town of Wright Ordinance No. 2022-03 An Ordinance of the Town of Wright, Wyoming confirming approval of the Re-Subdivision of Lots 10, 11, and 12 in Block 6 of Hay Creek Subdivision Filing Number 1, Town of Wright, Wyoming known as Lots 11A and 12A in Block 6 of Hay Creek Subdivision Filing Number 1, Town of Wright, Wyoming Correcting Errors in the Original Plat from 2014, Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Robb made a motion to approve the Governor's Proclamation proclaiming the week of May 1, 2022, through May 7, 2022, as Professional Clerks Week, Councilman Morgan seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. **ANNOUNCEMENTS:** There will be a public hearing on Monday May 9, 2022, at 7:00 p.m. at the Wright Town Hall to hear public comments on the fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget, with the regular Town Council to immediately follow the Public Hearing. **ADJUORNMENT:** With no further business Mayor Kingan adjourned the meeting at 7:56 p.m.
