Councilman Phipps made a motion to approve the **third** read of the Town of Wright Ordinance No. 2022-03 An Ordinance of the Town of Wright, Wyoming confirming approval of the Re-Subdivision of Lots 10, 11, and 12 in Block 6 of Hay Creek Subdivision Filing Number 1, Town of Wright, Wyoming known as Lots 11A and 12A in Block 6 of Hay Creek Subdivision Filing Number 1, Town of Wright, Wyoming Correcting Errors in the Original Plat from 2014, Councilman Morgan seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Phipps made a motion to approve Resolution 2022-07 A Resolution Authorizing the Submission of An Application for Federal Funding Through the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) to be Administered by the Wyoming Department of Transportation for the Town of Wright for the purpose of the Bike Path Project, Councilman Schrader seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes. Councilman Morgan made a motion to approve the amendment to the 2022 One Percent Tax Education and Survey Agreement correcting the amount of the contract from \$19,485.00 to \$25,000.00 and to amend the Town of Wright's obligation from \$740.43 to \$950.00, Councilman Phipps seconded the motion. Motion carried with all ayes.
