WHAT IS PLANNING?

Planning is the ongoing attempt to guide current and future development and redevelopment of a neighborhood, community, or region to promote the public health, safety, and welfare; to be prepared to take advantage of future opportunities; and to create and maintain a desirable environment.

THE PLANNING COMMISSION IS AN APPOINTED ADVISORY BODY WHICH:

- Receive its charge from the Town Council which receives its authority from the state enabling legislation.
- Evaluate information from staff, other public agencies, and testimony gathered in public hearings regarding development proposals, ordinance amendments, and other land use and community issues to make recommendations to the governing body.
- Review development for compliance with adopted standards and supports its decisions with finding of fact based on the health, safety, and welfare of citizens, and guided by the Master Plan.
- Serve as a feedback mechanism to inform the governing body what citizens want and where the best long-range interests of the community lie; and
- Research, study, and generate ideas on planning issues to guide community land use planning.
- Position is a 3-year term.

Interested parties shall be qualified electors of the municipality and who shall serve without compensation; however, training is available at no cost to you.

Meetings are regularly held on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of every month at 7:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. All meetings of the Commission are public meetings; open to the public always, except as otherwise provided.
