On Monday, February 9, 2026, at 7:00 pm Mayor Ralph Kingan led the Pledge of Allegiance and called the regular Town Council meeting to order with the following being present: Mayor Ralph Kingan, Councilman Doug Schrader, Councilman Mike Phipps, Councilman Jason Lembke, Councilman Justin Robb. and Clerk/Treasurer Barbara Craig.
